The Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines Group has completed a class determination for the above named products based on the information provided by the applicant.

Determination

This product is defined as an agricultural compound under the ACVM Act 1997.

This product is exempt under the ACVM (Exemptions and Prohibited Substances) Regulations 2011 subject to applicable conditions in Regulations 7 to 13, and Schedule [2].

These products do not require registration under the ACVM Act to be imported, marketed, distributed, sold or used in New Zealand.

Rationale

The product is used to directly manage plants and is defined as an agricultural compound under the ACVM Act 1997.

The product's intended use as a homeopathic agricultural chemical is exempt from registration under Schedule [2] of the ACVM (E&PS) Regulations 2011.

The conditions are any conditions set out in relation to that agricultural compound in column 2 of Schedule 2, and the applicable conditions in Regulations 7 to 13 of the ACVM (E&PS) Regulations 2011.
